


Download or send application map

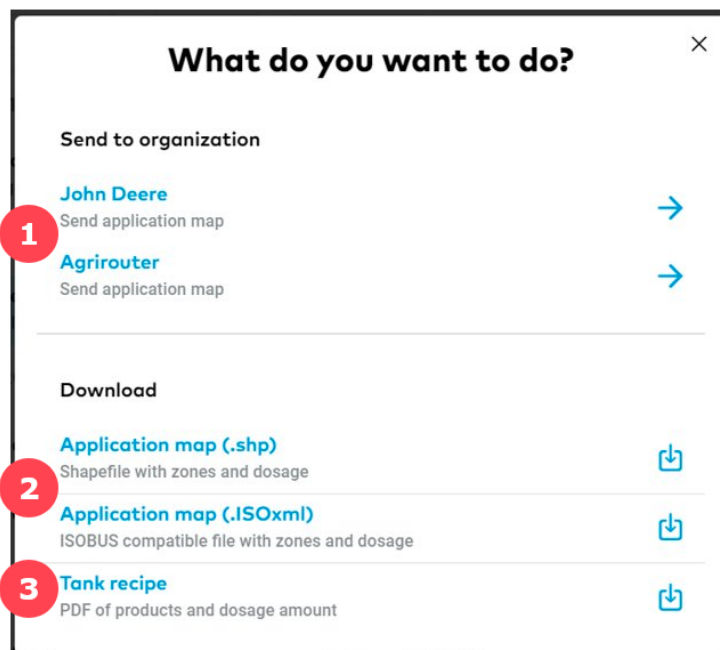
After planning and creating a task ([nutrition](#), [seeding](#) or [crop protection](#)) in xarvio FIELD MANAGER, the next step is to download the application map and send it wirelessly or with a USB stick or via xarvio CONNECT to the terminal.

- Log into xarvio FIELD MANAGER.
- Go to **Tasks** section and click on any task to send or download the map.

1. List all created tasks. Click on any to view more details.
 2. Click to **add new task** to any field.
 3. Click **Upload as-applied map** to add new map and analyse it in the **Analytics** section.
 4. **Change date** of the task.
 5. **Edit** the details of the task - that is, date, product, dosage, and source map.
 6. **Remove** the task from the list.
 7. Click to **download** or directly **send** the application map.
- After clicking on **Send or Download**, you will see a new window with a few options: send the application maps to your John Deere or Agrirouter account (if you have one) or simply download the file in .shp/.ISOxml format.



1. **Send** map directly to your MyJohnDeere or Agrirouter account.

2. **Download** an application map in any of the available formats and use a USB stick to transfer it to your terminal.



Before downloading the map, make sure your terminal supports one of the available application map formats: .shp or .ISOxml

3. Click to download a **Tank recipe** for documentation purpose.
